- 305 **14 HANDS, 2013, COLUMBIA VALLEY** - Bright, juicy red featuring aromas of blueberries and currants with subtle hints of dried herbs. Red berry flavors are complemented by a touch of spicy oak and accentuated by refined tannins. .... \$15.00
- 203 **ALEXANDER VALLEY CABERNET FRANC, 2013** - Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, vanilla and chocolate with flavors of plum, black cherry, vanilla, blueberry and cassis. This is a rich, lush wine with a nice balance of fruit and a structured finish. .... \$32.00
